## November 24/05 - Chairmans Report on activities undertaken on behalf of the Parish Council.

Cllr Welch updated on recent resident consultation:

Flooding at end of the church is very hazardous

Council was thanked for the speedy response to the soakaway, however it was fed back that NLC have not yet resolved the issue.

Following previous minutes Cllr Welch confirmed that the local volunteer Litter picker is still living in the parish, which is great.

Cllr Welch thanked all Cllrs in their support with the distributing of the Round Robin – the magazine still received positive feedback

Singleton and Birch liaison meeting attended – they advised that they still aim to achieve zero carbon and a proposal for hydrogen plant where the Eco park was, this has developed since last meeting.

The current plant is on hold it was noted that the Centrica project would make a difference to natural gas usage and 40% reduction in carbon.

No update on carbon capture pipeline.

No complaints about the maize trailer this year as used a different route.

Landfill will recommence in the spring, nearly complete.

Issue with a conveyor that needs 12 weeks' road closure to resolve between the quarry and Croxton
